The School of Life Sciences has an exciting opportunity for a Professor in Anatomy to provide strategic leadership for the development of Anatomy as an academic discipline within the School. Anatomy has a long and distinguished reputation at the University of Glasgow and benefits from one of the largest body donation programmes in the UK. The anatomy facility hosts excellent research and teaching facilities, including a state-of-the-art clinical skills centre to provide innovative education and training in partnership with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow. The University also houses the Museum of Anatomy including wonderful historic collections donated by William Hunter.

The University was awarded Times Higher Education University of the Year 2020 and student demand for places on the School's BSc programme in anatomy is strong. The University of Glasgow was ranked 5th in the UK for undergraduate anatomy and physiology in the Complete University Guide 2021 and consistently ranks in 1st or 2nd place in the UK for the study of medicine, nursing and dentistry. Anatomy teaching is at the centre of pre-clinical education. In addition, there is substantial demand from international students seeking opportunities to study abroad, resulting in the creation of courses specifically targeted at students seeking graduate entry to Medicine in the US.

The School of Life Sciences is one of three Schools in the College of Medical, Veterinary and Life Sciences which is the largest of the University's four Colleges as well as seven thematic Research Institutes, there is unrivalled opportunity for research collaboration and access to specialist equipment and facilities.

We welcome applications from candidates who hold a PhD and extensive postdoctoral work in a subject area closely allied to Anatomy.
