

THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE AT THE JOHANNES KEPLER UNIVERSITY LINZ ANNOUNCES A FACULTY OPENING FOR A UNIVERSITY PROFESSOR IN ANATOMY AND CELL BIOLOGY

The Faculty of Medicine at the Johannes Kepler University Linz invites applications for a private law employment position as

a Professor of Anatomy and Cell Biology

to begin immediately. The appointment is in accordance with § 98 of the 2002 Universities Act. An evaluation will follow after a five-year period.

The successful candidate is expected to represent and further develop the field of anatomical research, teaching and advance medical training to its full extent. The professorship includes managing the Institute for Anatomy and Cell Biology.

The successful candidate must hold a post-doctorate (*venia docendi*) degree (or a comparable, internationally recognized post-doctorate qualification) in the above-mentioned field. Please see <http://www.jku.at/professuren> for detailed information about the position. The successful candidate should also supplement the research focus at the existing faculty.

As part of the application process, the JKU can opt to additionally assess the candidate's qualification through an on-site visit of the applicant's current workplace.

A net salary as stated in the university collective agreement will be offered (Pay Grade: A1). If the candidate has additional, corresponding qualifications, salary can be negotiated on an individual basis.

The Johannes Kepler University Linz wishes to increase the proportion of female faculty and, for this reason, especially welcomes applications from qualified women. If applicants are equally qualified, women will be given preference for this appointment. The university welcomes applications from qualified applicants with physical disabilities. These applications will be given special consideration.

Prospective applicants interested in the position are requested to electronically send a complete application (including an application form and current CV) in adherence to the stated criteria in the job profile, together with the requested documentation to the Rector of the Johannes Kepler University Linz (<https://forms.jku.at/pm/professurmed>) by July 03, 2019.

If documents cannot be sent electronically, they are to be sent in quintuplet copy and should arrive at the Rector's office no later than one week after the end of the application deadline.
