Application deadline for the Michael Frotscher-Prize for Neuroanatomy 2026:

June 30, 2026

The Michael Frotscher-Prize for Neuroanatomy 2026 will be awarded at the 120. Annual Meeting of the Anatomische Gesellschaft in Bielefeld (22 - 25 September, 2026).

Successful applications need to include a single outstanding research publication that was published by the applicant (first or last author) between July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2026. This prize is dedicated to young scientists who have completed their doctoral thesis within the last five years. Both, self-applications as well as nominations by members of the Anatomische Gesellschaft are welcome. Applicants should be members of the Anatomische Gesellschaft and work in an anatomical institute. Please add to your application:

- CV
- list of publications
- brief description of your own research career
- declaration that the applicant has not simultaneously applied for other awards
- author contributions


