PROFESSORSHIP ANATOMY AND DEVELOPMENTAL BIOLOGY (F/M/D)

Experience in planning and implementation of anatomic dissecting courses and in the use of electronic media in the construction of IT-supported learning-environments are requested/welcome. The candidate will also be expected to have the ability and willingness to teach at all curricular levels (bachelor's, master's, doctoral), to supervise students' scientific work and to promote young scientists.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

1. Graduation in medicine (MD) with a PhD degree or equivalents
2. Outstanding teaching experience and publication record
3. Proven experience in a relevant position
4. Strong record in international research
5. Management experience and leadership skills
6. Skills in gender and diversity mainstreaming

In the case of equal qualifications, women are given priority.
